At a meeting of Ransom County, held on June 2nd, 2026, the following resolution as presented.

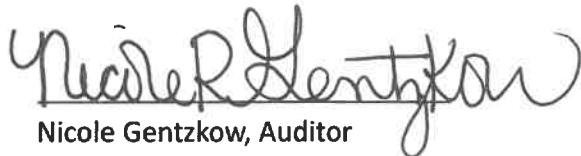
